Important Safety Alert: Dangers of Leaving a Car Running in Garages

Leaving a car running inside a garage, even for a short time, can be extremely dangerous due to the risk of carbon monoxide (CO) poisoning. Carbon monoxide is a colorless, odorless gas produced by engines, and it can build up quickly in enclosed spaces like a garage.

When a car is left running in a garage, CO levels can rise to lethal amounts within minutes. This toxic gas can seep into your & your neighbors' homes through gaps in doors and walls, putting residents at risk. Symptoms of CO poisoning include headache, dizziness, nausea, and confusion, which can escalate to unconsciousness or even death if exposure continues.

To prevent these risks, always ensure the garage door is fully open when starting your car. **Never leave a vehicle idling inside a closed or partially closed garage.** It's a simple step that can protect your health and save lives.
